DAY 1!

READ Exodus 2:1-10

Go grab a sheet of paper and a parent, a sibling, or a best friend. Draw a picture together by taking turns. The first person draws whatever they want for 30 seconds and then it's the second person's turn. Go back and forth for a few minutes.

Miriam and her mother worked together to be creative. God made all of us in His image and that means we can pull from each other's creativity too!

Thank God for giving us other people to get even more creative with!

Miriam thought quick by suggesting that she knew someone to help Pharaoh's daughter take care of the baby. Basically, Moses' mom was paid to take care of her own son. IMPOSSIBLE! But God made it so! That's thinking outside of the box! With God, anything is possible!

Fill a glass half full with water. Place an egg into the water. What happens?
